

DESCRIPTION OF THE COURSE OF LEARNING ARABIC THROUGH STORIES

This is a series of teaching through stories and tales aimed at developing reading and speaking skills in an interesting and enjoyable way. It includes various exercises aimed at memorizing the learned material.

The stories belong to the pen of [Suwaifi Fathi](#), who is one of the most prominent teachers of Arabic as a foreign language. He is the author of a number of [educational books](#), which are built on the basis of effective methods and meet modern educational criteria, and are also well designed. One of the strengths of Suwaifi Fathi is that it does not prioritize only theoretical or practical aspects, but organically and comprehensively combines them.

Purpose of the course:

Considering the fact that the student does not always have the opportunity to meet the teacher face to face, this course has been designed with the aim that it will be of equal help to the teacher and the student. Its purpose is to help the student in independent work on the development of reading and speaking skills, based on stories with graphic and audio accompaniment. Also, the texts are accompanied by electronic exercises that allow the student to self-assess and independently correct his errors.

Who is this course for?

The course is designed for students who study Arabic as a foreign language at the A1 level.

Course content:

1. Text for reading with audio recording and illustrations.
2. Translation of words in the Quizlet program to facilitate their memorization by the student.
3. Questions on the content of the text, presented in the form of electronic questions, after answering which the student receives a point and sees his mistakes. The test can be taken several times.

After completing this course, you will:

1. Get to know ten stories that reveal Arab culture in an interesting, exciting and relaxed way.
2. Learn 100 new words.
3. Practice listening and reading comprehension skills.

4. Practice your reading skills.

How to use this course?

1. Open the Quizlet link and study the new vocabulary of the text.

2. Listen to the story and try to understand its main idea.

3. Listen to the video again to understand more of the ideas contained in it.

4. Do the exercises after each story.

5. After completing all the tasks, you can open the file with the translation of the story and check whether you understood it correctly. The site is programmed so that you will not be able to open the translation before completing the task.

6. The course is programmed to automatically open the second story for you as soon as you answer the last two quizzes from the first story, and so on

In addition, dear student, you can do the following:

- Write down all the new words and make a sentence with each word
- Read the story aloud and make an audio recording
- After you have studied the story properly, you can retell it, maybe in different words or briefly, and make an audio recording.
